The PED Framework proposed by the PED Programme has been discussed and acknowledged widely. We thank all national delegates and stakeholders for their input so far. The key results of the discussions have been integrated in the document "White Paper: PED Reference Framework for Positive Energy Districts and Neighbourhoods". Elaboration of a strategy towards operationalisation of the PED Framework towards cities' needs is now a priority.

On basis of the White Paper, the PED Programme invites experts and representatives of problem-owners to discuss and co-create (1) key aspects that need further elaboration for cities and (2) key elements of processes to further operationalise the proposed PED Framework.

- Group sessions elaborating key areas for the PED Framework operationalisation
